Company Name Change

WHEREAS, Purchaser and Vendor desire that the Master Price Agreement shall be amended in part to reflect the company name change.


NOW, THEREFORE, Purchaser and Vendor enter into the following:

AMENDMENT TO MASTER PRICE AGREEMENT


